

Mission FAQs 2025

1. General Information:

- 27th annual Sr. High Youth Group Mission Trip
- We leave for East Bank, WV on July 6th and return on July 12th
- We have been to West Virginia on a previous trip and are excited to go back
- We have 52 spots reserved (41 youth and 11 adults)

2. What We're Doing:

- Joining about 400 other teens and adult leaders from across the country to perform hands-on repair projects for the less fortunate
- Typical projects include painting, roofing, dry-walling, and carpentry
- We'll be staying at a local school and sleeping on classroom floors
- This is the 25th year we've teamed up with Group Mission Trips

3. About Group Mission Trips:

- A non-profit organization with 40+ years of experience organizing mission trips for Jr. and Sr. High Students
- Will conduct over 150 US and international camps this year
- Group Mission Trips arranges everything including incredible non-denominational faith-building programs each evening

4. How Much it Costs:

- The cost is \$600/person so we need to raise about \$32,000 this year
- Most of the money is used by Group Mission Trips to buy the building materials and supplies we'll be using to do the home repairs
- The rest covers food, administrative, and miscellaneous expenses like trash removal, ice, and a work camp t-shirt
- We can only host a limited number of fundraisers so we need to raise a large portion of our funds through individual and corporate sponsorships

5. What are Individual and Corporate Sponsorships:

- Tax deductible contributions
- We're asking businesses, relatives, friends, neighbors, teachers, etc. to sponsor us
- Funds go directly into personal accounts
